IN MEMORIAM

Tom Tardy has a diverse background of litigation experience. Tom has tried First Amendment cases, oil and gas cases, and personal injury cases for both plaintiffs and defendants. However, he has achieved national acclaim for his representation of clients in mass tort cases. For over 40 years, he has successfully litigated mass tort claims nationally, regionally, and locally on behalf of dozens of defendants, including manufacturers and suppliers of products and equipment such as brakes, pumps, compressors, boilers, electrical equipment, and others.
